

Donation Criteria for Habitat ReStore

The Habitat for Humanity ReStore of Alamance County will accept the following items for donation. If you have items to donate that are not listed below, please call the store at (336) 222-8292 to see if they are acceptable.

Hardware

Complete sets of door hardware
Any quantity of hinges, nails, screws, hangers, etc.

Lighting

Good to excellent condition (no can lights)

Lumber and sheetrock

6 feet or longer
Trim and molding 5 feet or longer
Sheetrock 4x8 or larger

Miscellaneous

Free-standing wood stoves
Garden tools (in working order)
Hand tools and power tools (in working order)
HVAC units (5 years old or newer)
Shutters

Paint and wall coverings

Latex paint only (unopened and unused)
Wallpaper, borders, tools and glue

Plumbing

Bathtubs
Hardware, fittings
Shower enclosures (no cracks or stains)
Toilets (residential only)

Appliances

Microwaves
Ranges and hoods
Refrigerators
Washers/Dryers

Windows

Double-hung, picture, bay (without rot, cracks or foggy glass, no single-pane Windows)

Architectural items

Antiques
Columns
Mantels
Porch posts/railings

Cabinetry

In good condition with intact doors and drawers
Full kitchen and bathroom sets
Individual pieces
Countertops with straight sections
Hardware

Doors, residential only

Entryway units
Exterior or interior doors (no rot, cracks or missing panes)
Pre-hung door slabs (no taller than 84 inches)

Flooring

Hardwood/parquet (25 sq ft or more)
New Carpet
New padding
New vinyl tiles or vinyl sheets
Slate, marble and ceramic tiles

Furniture

In good condition & structurally sound
Hardwood tables and chairs
Case goods
